EMERGENCY SMALL BUSINESS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

On August 3, 2021 the City Council approved the application for the Emergency Small Business Financial Assistance Grant Program. This grant can be applied for by any small business in lone that suffered economic losses due to Covid-19. Each business can apply for this grant to cover operating expenses and working capital, furniture, fixtures and equipment, capital improvements or to pay off high interest credit card debt. A business may apply up to an amount not to exceed \$5,000. See full application for all eligibility requirements. Applications are due as soon as possible and will be reviewed immediately upon receipt. The filing period will end on March 31, 2022.

Amador COVID-19 Update:

Amador County Public Health reports 80 more cases of COVID-19 reported since the July 13th update, bringing the total laboratory confirmed case count to 1,958. 7 Amador County residents are currently hospitalized due to COVID-19. Amador Public Health will be offering COVID-19 vaccine at pop-up outreach clinics. Check the Amador Vaccine Information website for future clinics.
