SUBJECT: SITE PLAN REVIEW – 702 HUNTER LANE RAIL EXPLORERS

General Plan Designation: Special Planning Area

Zoning: (M-1) Limited Manufacturing and Industrial

Current Use: Vacant and undeveloped land

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Open the public hearing and take public comment; and

2. Adopt a Resolution Approving the Site Plan Review Permit for the 702 Hunter Lane Rail Explorers Facility Project (Attachment A).

#### BACKGROUND:

The applicant, Rail Explorers, in partnership with the Amador Central Railroad, is requesting approval of a Site Plan Review permit in order to develop a guided railbike tour facility and offer guided railbike tours on the existing Amador Central Railroad tracks (Rail Explorers Facility Project or Project). The proposed project includes the installation of temporary structures and improvements, including a storage container, officer trailer, a self-contained restroom trailer, and a ticket office. The Rail Explorers Facility Project is proposed at 702 Hunter's Lane, APN 005-130-005, approximately 400 feet west of State Route CA-124 and adjacent to the Amador Central Railroad tracks. The Project Application materials are provided as Attachment B.

As identified in Section 17.10.090, Site Plan Review, of the City of Ione Zoning Code, a discretionary site plan review permit is required for all non-residential development. A site plan review permit will be granted only when the decision-making authority makes all of the following findings:

1. The proposed project is consistent with the objectives of the general plan, complies with applicable zoning regulations, planned development master plan or specific plan provisions, improvements standards, and other applicable standards and regulations adopted by the city.

- 2. The proposed project will not create safety conflicts with vehicular, bicycle, or pedestrian transportation modes of circulation.
- 3. The site layout (orientation and placement of buildings and parking areas), as well as the landscaping, lighting, and other development features are compatible with adjacent residential and non-residential uses; and
- 4. The proposed project will not have an adverse impact on public health or safety.

The decision-making authority may modify plans in whole or in part and may condition the site plan review permit to ensure specific design features and conformance with all applicable provisions of the Zoning Code.

#### **ANALYSIS**:

The purpose of the proposed Project is for Rail Explorers to offer recreational guided railbike tours in partnership with the Amador Central Railroad. The proposed Project consists of the development of an approximately 0.9-acre portion of the 15.3-acre site (APN 005-130-005) with a storage container, office trailer, self-contained restroom trailer and a converted storage container to act as a ticket office adjacent to the Amador Central Railroad line. The proposed improvements to the site consist of modular buildings and trailers that are not proposed to be installed on permanent foundations, a gravel parking area, and a gravel boarding area. The proposed Project is a daytime operation, operating within the daylight hours of 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. The proposed guided railbike tours are designed to be conducted to the east, in the direction of Sunnybrook. The proposed Rail Explorers facility is shown in Figure 1 below and will include:

- A 20' x 8' ticket office;
- A 40' x 8'storage container;
- A 38' x 8' office trailer;
- Guest seating area of approximately 120' x 100';
- A 275'-long boarding area consisting of gravel;
- A 22' x 8' bathroom trailer; and
- A 125' x 70' parking area consisting of 20 parking spaces, including one accessible space pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The analysis below addresses the proposed project's consistency with the City of Ione General Plan and City of Ione Zoning Code, including the findings required for approval of a discretionary site plan review permit.

Section 17.10.090 – Site Plan Review of the Ione Zoning Code requires approval of a <u>site plan review permit</u> for this Project. The proposed Project will be beneficial to the City and will provide necessary recreational and revenue-generating services to the City.

#### General Plan Consistency

The proposed Project is designated by the General Plan as Special Planning Area (SPA) and is within the Industrial Park Policy Area, as shown in General Plan Figure 3-5 and illustrated on Figure 2 below. The land use policy and vision for the Industrial Park Policy Area is for a predominant development pattern of light and heavy industrial uses, with some commercial and office development as well (General Plan Policy LU-1.0). The proposed Project includes a portion of the Industrial Park Policy Area of the SPA. Future land planning in the Industrial Park Policy Area shall be substantially consistent with the Conceptual Land Use Plan for the Industrial Park Policy Area, as contained in Figure 3-14 of the General Plan (as shown in Figure 2 below). The project is consistent with the Conceptual Land Use Designation of the Industrial Park Policy Area as it proposes commercial recreation uses, which would not conflict with the industrial and commercial uses conceptually envisioned and conforms to the City's tree preservation ordinance as no trees are proposed to be removed. Further, the proposed use consists of temporary improvements that can be removed should the owner of the Project site proceed with an application for a more intensive industrial and commercial development as envisioned by General Plan Policy LU-1.10.

As noted in the General Plan Land Use Element Policy LU-1.10, light industrial development in this area should be consistent with the General Plan land use classification of Light Industrial and shall have Floor-Area-Ratios (FARs) ranging from a minimum of 0.25 to a maximum of 0.75. Heavy industrial development shall be consistent with the Heavy Industrial designation and shall have FARs ranging from a minimum of 0.10 to a maximum of 0.75. General commercial should be consistent with the General Commercial designation, with FARs ranging from a minimum of 0.25 to a maximum of 1.0. Office Commercial shall have FARs ranging from 0.35 to a maximum of 1.5. The maximum development capacities for this Policy Area are as follows:

• Light Industrial: 2,134,440 square feet;

• Heavy Industrial: 4,003,164 square feet;

• Office: 2,012,472 square feet;

• Retail-Commercial: 1,439,658 square feet

The improvements associated with the Project would have a FAR of approximately 0.018, which is below the minimum required FAR ratio of 0.25 for General Commercial uses at 0.024. However, the proposed Project does not include any permanent structures and is not the primary use of the property. As the proposed uses are not permanent uses and the uses are allowed as ancillary uses under the Zoning Code, the FAR requirement is anticipated to only apply to permanent structures and to not be applicable to the Project. For additional information, see the Zoning Code discussion below.

Therefore, the proposed Project is consistent with the General Plan land use classification of General Commercial.

The development of the site is consistent with the following General Plan guidance:

- The Conservation and Open Space Element, which addresses the importance of recreational opportunities being provided throughout the City.
- The Public Facilities Element, which promotes efficiency, agency collaboration, and community design in the provision, location, and operation of public facilities and services.
  - Policy PF-2.3: Public facilities and services shall be equitably distributed throughout the community to enhance the quality of life.
- The Land Use Element Policy LU-1.10 stating that: Land planning should consider that the existing heavy rail lines may be retrofitted in the future and pose opportunities for shipping and serve as connections between Ione and the greater region, State, and nation. The land plan shall be designed to protect heritage trees within the Policy Area pursuant to the City's tree preservation ordinance. The Project takes advantage of the recreational opportunities afforded by the Amador Central Railroad facility and has been designed to avoid impacts to trees within the Project area.

As described within the application materials and site plan, the Project will be designed to provide additional outdoor commercial recreation opportunities to residents of Ione and

visitors to the region and will contribute to the city's necessary recreational and revenuegenerating services to the City.

### **Zoning Code Consistency**

The Project site, which is a portion of a larger parcel, is zoned M-1 and is located adjacent to land zoned M-1 to the north and east and land zoned B-P (Business Professional) to the west and land zoned C-3 (Heavy Commercial) and M-1 to the south and southwest as shown in Figure 2. The Project's consistency with applicable provisions of the Zoning Code is discussed below.

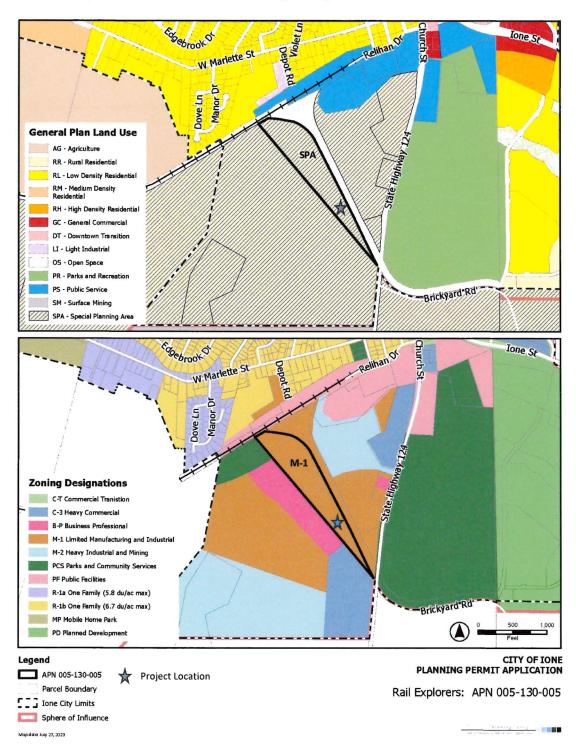
#### Zoning District - Allowed Uses

Section 17.24.020(C) - Characteristics of Commercial and Industrial Districts: The M-1 Limited Manufacturing Zoning District is described as follows:

This district is intended for low to medium-intensity industrial uses that involve the manufacturing, fabrication, assembly, or processing of primarily finished materials, which occur entirely within an enclosed building. These activities, along with supportive and complementary uses, such as storage, shipping, retail, wholesale, or sales operations, are allowed in this district. Uses in this district should pose limited environmental impact in terms of noise, odors, traffic, hazardous materials, and other health and safety risks. In addition, the development standards are designed to promote attractive development that is compatible with surrounding development. Sites designated for M-1 uses should be located on medium to large sites along highways, thoroughfares, arterials, or collectors adjacent to other office, industrial, or commercial uses. Residential uses of any kind are prohibited in this district with the exception of a caretaker residence. Development should be auto-accommodating with sufficient and clearly defined parking and loading areas.

Pursuant to Section 17.24.030, Allowed Land Uses and Permit Requirements, Outdoor Commercial Recreation facilities are permitted within the M-1 Limited Manufacturing and Industrial Zoning District subject to a discretionary Site Plan Review, provided that it does not exceed ten percent of the primary structure footprint. The total leased land on the parcel that is proposed for use by the Project is approximately 40,000 square feet and therefore, the M-1 zoning district for the project site allows for a 10,000 – 30,000 square foot primary structure on the project site, according to the FAR requirements of 0.25 – 0.75. The total temporary structure area of the proposed Project is approximately 960 square feet, or approximately 0.096 to 0.024 percent of the minimum or maximum primary structure, respectively. Therefore, the proposed Project is less than 10 percent of the allowed primary structure area. The proposed Project is consistent with these standards as the proposed Project is subject to a discretionary Site Plan Review permit and the proposed Project does not include any permanent structures, so does not result in development that would exceed the 10 percent of allowed primary structure footprint maximum. Further, the proposed use As there is no primary structure at this time, the proposed Project and does not exceed ten percent of the primary structure footprint.

As provided in the application materials, the proposed Project includes storing of facility components within storage containers to prevent unauthorized access, climbing, vandalism, graffiti, and other conditions which would result in hazardous conditions, visual blight, or unattractive nuisances.

As provided in the application materials and shown in Table 1 above, the proposed Project is consistent with all required front and interior side setbacks of 25 feet and rear setbacks of 0 feet of the M-1 Zoning Districts. Furthermore, the proposed Project is consistent with the 75 ft./6 stories maximum height limit of the M-1 zoning district.

The proposed Project is below the minimum required FAR ratio of 0.25 for Commercial uses within the M-1 zoning district at 0.024, as shown in table 1 above. According to this requirement, the M-1 zoning district for this site allows for a 10,000 to 30,000 square foot commercial use on the project site. However, the proposed Project is not the primary use of the property and is allowed as an ancillary use, not to exceed ten percent of the primary structure footprint. Therefore, the proposed Project is consistent with the development standards of the M-1 zoning district as it does not exceed 10 percent of the primary structure allowed footprint.

As provided in the application materials, the proposed Project includes only minimal directional and safety lighting. The Project includes outdoor flood lights attached to the structures for closing procedures and are directed downward to avoid spillover onto adjacent properties. Additionally, these lights would be on motion sensors to turn on and off as needed, consistent with operating hours.

The Conditions of Approval, provided as Exhibit 1 to the Resolution (see Attachment A) address compliance with City, State, and Federal laws and regulations, operation of the Project, traffic safety, lighting, maintenance of the Project site, and ensuring public health, safety, and welfare.

#### Site Plan Review Permit Findings

As described above, the Project meets the findings for Site Plan Review. The proposed Project is consistent with the General Plan, Zoning Code, and applicable City standards and regulations.

The proposed Project is designed in a manner that maintains and enhances existing landscaping on the site; the height limit is consistent with the maximum building height of the zoning district of the subject parcel; the Project is consistent with required setbacks; the Project is required to be designed so as to be resistant to and minimize opportunities for unauthorized access, climbing, vandalism, graffiti, and other conditions which would result in hazardous conditions, visual blight, or attractive nuisances; and the Project is designed to minimize the visual impact to the greatest extent feasible.

The establishment and maintenance of the proposed Project will not be detrimental to the health, safety, peace, morals, comfort, or general welfare of residents or the general welfare of the city as the Project will be designed consistent with the development standards of the M-1 zoning district of the Zoning Code, California Building Standards Code, California Code of Regulations, and all local, state, and federal requirements. Furthermore, the application materials and site plan were reviewed by all City departments; including Fire, Police, Engineering, etc. Conditions of the reviews by each department are included in the Conditions of Approval.

The Project does not include features that would create safety conflicts with vehicular, bicycle, or pedestrian transportation modes of circulation. The application materials includes a Traffic Control Plan and ADA requirements that have been reviewed by the City Engineer and the City Engineer has identified that the plans included in the application are adequate for vehicular, bicycle, and pedestrian transportation modes.

The site layout (orientation and placement of the guided railbike facility), as well as the lighting, and other development features are compatible with adjacent uses as all proposed lighting facilities are required to be directed and operated in a manner which avoids spillover onto adjacent properties. Additionally, no residential uses are located adjacent to the site.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:**

The Project is exempt from CEQA in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, Section 15303, and Section 15304. Section 15301, Existing Facilities, consists of exemption of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. As described above, the proposed Project involves no expansion of the railroad facility that is currently used by Amador Central Railroad and will use the existing railroad facility for the guided railbike tours. Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, exempts construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. As an example, the new construction of a small structure is considered exempt from the requirements of CEQA if a store, motel, office, restaurant or similar structure does not involve the use of significant amounts of hazardous substances, and does not exceed 2,500 square feet in floor area. Section 15304, Minor Alterations to Land, exempts minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. As described above, the proposed Project consists of the placement of temporary structures totaling approximately 960 square feet in floor area, minor improvements to the Project site, the Project does not propose the use of significant amounts of hazardous substances, and the Project would not remove any trees. As such, it does not have the potential to result in a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. None of the exceptions identified by CEOA Guidelines Section 15300.2 apply to the project. As such, it does not have the potential to result in a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission adopt Resolution No. 23—: A Resolution of the Planning Commission of the City of Ione Approving the Site Plan Review Permit for the 702 Hunter Lane Rail Explorers Facility Project.

# A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF IONE APPROVING THE SITE PLAN REVIEW PERMIT FOR THE 702 HUNTER LANE RAIL EXPLORERS FACILITY PROJECT

WHEREAS, the applicant, Rail Explorers, in partnership with the Amador Central Railroad, is requesting approval of a site plan review permit for the installation of a guided railbike facility project (Project) at 702 Hunter Lane adjacent to the Amador Central Railroad; and

WHEREAS, the Project applicant submitted required application materials for consideration of a Site Plan Review permit; and

WHEREAS, the Project application materials were circulated to City departments for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been designed and conditioned to meet the standards identified in the Zoning Code, including Chapter 17.24, Commercial and Industrial Districts, and to address the findings required for a Site Plan Review as established by Section 17.21.050 as described in the Staff Report to the Planning Commission;

WHEREAS, the project is categorically exempt from CEQA under CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, Existing Facilities, and Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, and Section15304, Minor Alterations to Land, and does not conflict with any of the identified exceptions under CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2, as the proposed Project will use the existing Amador Central Railroad facilities and is composed of small improvements. Therefore, the project is not subject to CEQA; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2023 at a regular/special meeting the Planning Commission held a public hearing at which time interested persons had an opportunity to testify regarding the proposed site plan review; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission carefully considered the staff report, testimony, and Project materials related to the site plan review.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Planning Commission of the City of Ione approves the site plan review permit for the Rail Explorers subject to the following conditions of approval:

- 1. The proposed project is categorically exempt from CEQA under Section 15301, Existing Facilities, and Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, and Section15304, Minor Alterations to Land, of the CEQA Guidelines and the Project does not require an exception to the exemption based on CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2.
- 2. The proposed use is consistent with the City of Ione General Plan and all applicable provisions of Title 17, Zoning Code.
- 3. The proposed project is consistent with the objectives of the General Plan, complies with applicable zoning regulations, planned development master plan or specific plan provisions, improvements standards, and other applicable standards and regulations adopted by the city.
- 4. The proposed project will not create safety conflicts with vehicular, bicycle, or pedestrian transportation modes of circulation.

- 5. The site layout (orientation and placement of structures and parking areas), as well as the landscaping, lighting, and other development features are compatible with adjacent residential and non-residential uses; and
- 6. The proposed project will not have an adverse impact on public health or safety.
- 7. #### **CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL**

- 1. Approval is granted for the Site Plan Review for the Rail Explorer's railbike facility as described in the application dated May 2, 2023 and supplemental materials provided by the Project applicant and included as Attachment B in the Planning Commission Staff Report for this item.
- 2. The approval is limited to the Project as proposed in Attachment B and modified by these Conditions of Approval. Any revision to the Project, including development of additional parking or improved areas, placement of additional temporary structures, or development of permanent structures, shall require a separate Project application, discretionary review, and approval of appropriate permits.
- 3. No sound may emanate from the property, which causes an undue disturbance more than one-hundred (100) feet from the event site or violates the Noise Ordinance. The Police Department has the authority to require modifications or require termination of the noise source in the event of a noise issue.
- 4. The Project shall be constructed, improved, and operated in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations, including City, State, and Federal laws and requirements.
- 5. All applicable permits shall be obtained from other agencies prior to commencement of this use, including, but not limited to City of Ione Public Works Department, City of Ione Building Department, City of Ione Police Department, City of Ione Fire Department, Amador Central Railroad, Amador County Public Health Department, Amador County Planning Department, and Amador County Environmental Health Department clearances.
- 6. The applicant shall ensure that a Traffic Control Plan and agreement with the Amador Central Railroad Corporation is reviewed, approved, and implemented to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
- 7. Any temporary improvements and debris shall be removed and restored to their former condition immediately following each day of use.
- 8. All structures, ancillary structures, temporary structures, storage containers, ticket booths, maintenance structures, loading platforms, fending, signage, parking facilities, boarding area, and all other permanent or temporary improvements on the site shall be maintained in good repair.
- 9. The Project site shall be maintained in a neat and clean manner and addressing any unsafe, hazardous nuisance or unsightly conditions, including but not limited to graffiti, vandalism, overgrowth of vegetation, obstruction by trees or plants, storage of water or refuse, storage of any inoperable equipment, and/or presence of other potential nuisances or hazards to the adjacent uses, adjoining properties, or the general public.
- 10. Hours of operation shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m daily. The City Planner shall have the authority to modify the hours of operation.

- 11. Lighting giving a ground level illumination of 1 foot-candle shall be provided in the parking area during the time accessible to the public and Project employees in non-daylight hours.
- 12. All lighting shall be shielded to prevent glare on contiguous properties and to prevent upward lighting.
- 13. Surface parking abutting a street shall be separated from the street by an ornamental fence, wall, or compact evergreen hedge having a height of not less than two feet and maintained at a height of not more than four feet.
- 14. The applicant shall ensure that all applicable stormwater quality requirements are met. All storm drains within the project are protected from debris and/or wash water.
- 15. The applicant shall ensure that the project is compliant with all applicable Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) act requirements.
- 16. The applicant shall ensure any electrical work shall be required to meet the California Electrical Code through the City of Ione Building Department.
- 17. The applicant shall ensure all roads and driving aisles within the Project site be a minimum width of 20 feet and an all-weather surface capable of supporting fire apparatus.
- 18. The applicant shall ensure that emergency vehicle access is provided pursuant to the standards and requirements of the City of Ione Fire Department.
- 19. The applicant shall ensure all weeds and wildland growth be kept cut to two inches (2") or less and a minimum of fifty feet (50') clearance.
- 20. The applicant shall ensure all temporary structures be equipped with proper exits and occupant load posted.
- 21. The applicant shall ensure all containers are equipped with a 2A10BC fire extinguisher.
- 22. The applicant shall ensure the address is posted is at least three inches (3") in height and visible from Hunter Lane.
- 23. All structures shall meet the requirements of Title 19 of the California Code of Regulations. No open fires are allowed within the vicinity of the project.
- 24. The City of Ione and its agents, officers, employees, and consultants shall be defended, indemnified, and held harmless from any claim, action or proceedings against the City, or its agents, officers and employees to attach, set aside, void, or annul the approval of this application or the environmental determination which accompanies it, or which otherwise arises out of or in connection with the City's action on this application, including but not limited to, damages, costs, expenses, attorney's fees, or expert witness fees.

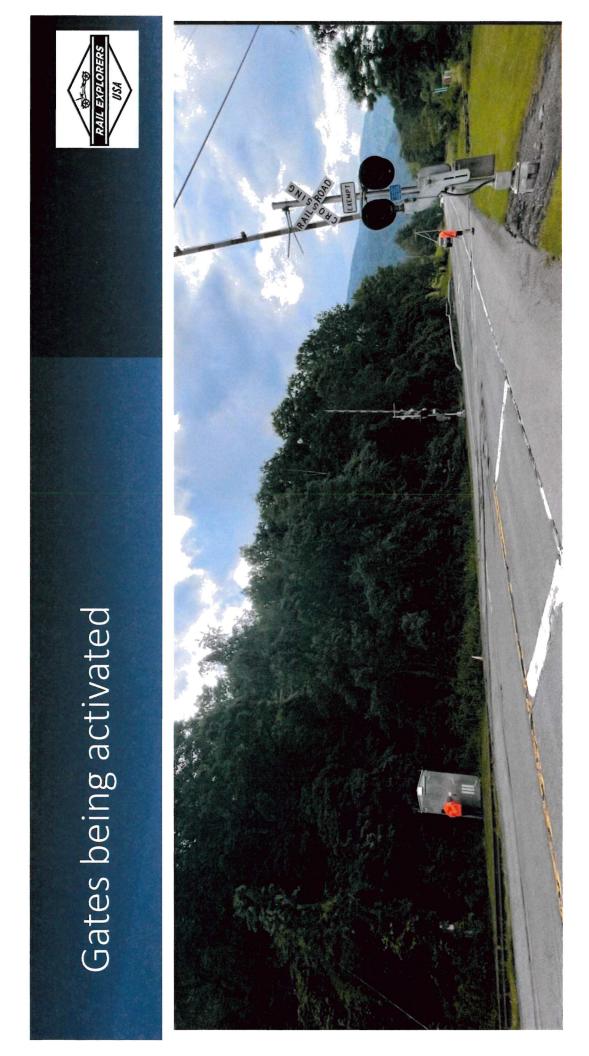
Rail Explores has been operating in Phoenicia NY (Catskills Division) since 2017. In this time of operation, Rail Explores has used the process detailed to the right with support photographs in the following slides. This is on State Highway 28 and is managed by the New York Department of transportation. In the last six years and over 115,000 riders there have been zero safety issues or concerns.

Rail Explorers intends to deploy the same traffic plan on CA-124 in Ione, CA.

# Process in Phoenicia NY that would be done in Ione on CA-124

- . When all bikes reach the crossing they are linked together with all steel couplers to cross as one unit.
  - Rear guide will signal to flagger when all bikes are safely linked together, as one unit, and it is clear to flip the switch for the crossing signals and gates to engage.

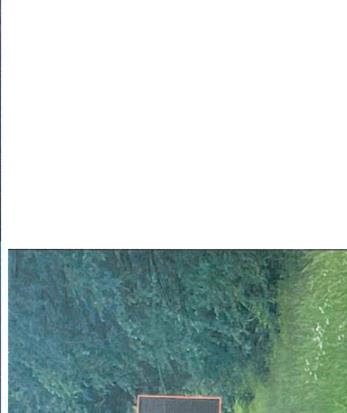

### REASONS WHY THIS PROJECT IS EXEMPT OR DOES NOT REQUIRE FURTHER ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION:

The Project is exempt from CEQA in accordance with CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, Section 15303, and Section 15304. Section 15301, Existing Facilities, consists of exemption of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. As described above, the proposed Project involves no expansion of the railroad facility that is currently used by Amador Central Railroad and will use the existing railroad facility for the guided railbike tours. Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, exempts construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. As an example, the new construction of a small structure is considered exempt from the requirements of CEQA if a store, motel, office, restaurant or similar structure does not involve the use of significant amounts of hazardous substances, and does not exceed 2,500 square feet in floor area. Section 15304, Minor Alterations to Land, exempts minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. As described above, the proposed Project consists of the placement of temporary structures totaling approximately 960 square feet in floor area, minor improvements to the Project site, the Project does not propose the use of significant amounts of hazardous substances, and the Project would not remove any trees. As such, it does not have the potential to result in a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

Each class includes examples for the exemption. The proposed project is consistent with the example provided at CEQA Guidelines Section 15303(c), "A store, motel, office, restaurant or similar structure not involving the use of significant amounts of hazardous substances, and not exceeding 2500 square feet in floor area. In urbanized areas, the exemption also applies to up to four such commercial buildings not exceeding 10,000 square feet in floor area on sites zoned for such use if not involving the use of significant amounts of hazardous substances where all necessary public services and facilities are available and the surrounding area is not environmentally sensitive." More specifically, the proposed Project:

- Is less than 2,500 square feet in floor area;
- Is located on a site zoned for the proposed use;
- Does not involve the use of significant amounts of hazardous substances; and
- · Is not environmentally sensitive.

For these reasons, the project qualifies under the basic criteria of CEQA Guidelines Section 15303. However, in addition to demonstrating consistency with the criteria at CEQA Guidelines Section 15303, the proposed project must also be reviewed to determine if any exceptions to the application of a categorical exemption are present pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 (Exceptions).

### **CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15300.2 (EXCEPTIONS):**

CEQA Guidelines §Section 15300.2 provides a list of exceptions for situations where categorical exemptions shall not be used because of the potential for significant environmental effects. The following text addresses each exception, as it relates to the proposed project.

15300.2(a) (Location): This exception states, "Classes 3, 4, 5, 6, and 11 are qualified by consideration of where the project is to be located – a project that is ordinarily insignificant in its impact on the environment may in a particularly sensitive environment be significant. Therefore, these classes are considered to apply all instances, except where the project may impact on an environmental resource of hazardous or critical concern where designated, precisely mapped, and officially adopted pursuant to law by federal, state, or local agencies." The project site's location does not include any environmental feature indicating that it is sensitive. The project itself consists of a new guided railbike facility on vacant land. The project site is also not listed on any governmental list of sites with a prior release of hazardous materials. For these reasons, the location exception at CEQA Guidelines §15300.2(a) does not apply to the project.

15300.2(b) (Cumulative Impact): This exception states, "All exemptions for these classes are inapplicable when the cumulative impact of successive projects of the same type in the same place, over time is significant." Because there have not, to date, been a succession of similar projects in the area, the cumulative impact exception of CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2(b) does not apply to the project.

15300.2(c) (Significant Effect): This exception states, "A categorical exemption shall not be used for an activity where there is a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances." The project site's location does not include any environmental feature indicating that it is sensitive, and the project would provide for a guided railbike facility that are similar to uses allowed within the area. For these reasons, there are no unusual circumstances applicable to the project or its site and the exception at CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2(c) does not apply to the project.

15300.2(d) (Scenic Highways): This exception states, "A categorical exemption shall not be used for a project which may result in damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to, trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources, within a highway officially designated as a state scenic highway. This does not apply to improvements which are required as mitigation by an adopted negative declaration or certified EIR." There are no state scenic highways within the City of Ione. Therefore, the exception at CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2(d) does not apply to the project.

15300.2(e) (Hazardous Waste Sites): This exception states, "A categorical exemption shall not be used for a project located on a site which is included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code." The project site is also not listed on any governmental list of sites with a prior release of hazardous materials. Therefore, the exception at CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2(e) does not apply to the project.

15300.2(f) (Historic Resources): This exception states, "A categorical exemption shall not be used for a project which may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historical resource." The project site consists of a vacant land. The project would result in the construction of a guided railbike facility. Therefore, there are no historic resources at the project site and the exception at CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2(f) does not apply to the project.

### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

1. Open the Public Hearing and receive public comment; and

2. Make a recommendation to the City Council regarding adoption of the Zoning Code Amendments.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Through a review of the City's Zoning Code, as amended in early 2023, incomplete parking requirements for commercial and residential uses were identified within Table 17.40.050-1, Parking Requirements by Land Use. The Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 Project would revise the Zoning Code to complete missing parking requirements for Studio units, One and Two Bedroom Units, Retail, Service, and Office Uses and Automotive and Vehicle Uses; consistent with consistent with similar uses in the Zoning Code, the City of Ione Downtown Plan, and similar jurisdictions.

### **DISCUSSION:**

The Planning Commission will be presented with the proposed Zoning Code Amendments for discussion. The amendments include changes to:

Specify number of required parking spaces by land use for Retail, Service, and Office
Uses (including Eating and Drinking Establishments and Offices, Business and
Professional) and Automotive and Vehicle Uses (including Auto Services and Car
Washing).

The absence of adequate parking requirements in the current Zoning Code results in the potential for businesses to potentially lack sufficient parking spaces to accommodate parking demand and creates uncertainty for the planning application review process. Therefore, revisions to the Zoning Code Table 17.40.050-1 are required to clearly delineate and identified specific parking requirements for Retail, Service, and Office Uses and Automotive and Vehicle Uses.

Parking requirements of comparable land uses in the existing Zoning Code of the City of Ione were compared with the Downtown Plan of the City of Ione, Jackson, Sutter Creek, and Amador



County. Table 1 summarizes parking requirements in the Ione Downtown Plan and of nearby jurisdictions.

The recommended changes to the Zoning Code are shown in track changes in Attachment B. The Project is applicable Citywide.

As shown in Attachment B, the Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 project will revise the Zoning Code to include parking space requirements for Eating and Drinking Establishments; Offices, Business and Professional; and Auto Services, Car Washing uses to be comparable to similar jurisdictions. The Auto Sales and Rental standards will also be reduced to be similar to comparable jurisdictions.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW**

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3), as it has been determined that the Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 Project will not cause a significant negative effect on the environment. The changes to the Zoning Code will not intensify land uses, result in land use incompatibilities, or generate other unmitigated impacts beyond those that would result from the existing Zoning Code and existing provisions of State law.

### PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Planning Commission adopt a resolution (draft resolution attached as Exhibit A) recommending the City Council adopt the ordinance amending Title 17, Zoning, Table 17.40.050-1 of the Ione Municipal Code.

WHEREAS, the Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 project includes changes to address requirements of parking spaces by land use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning Commission conducted a duly-noticed public hearing on August 8, 2023 to receive public comment, review the Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 project, and provide direction for revisions, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission considered public comment; and

WHEREAS, adoption and implementation of the Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 project is determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act as it meets with the criteria established in Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines because there will be no physical changes to the environment and requires no further review pursuant to Section 15168(c)(2); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds that the Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 project is compatible with the general objectives of the General Plan, in that the amendments implement and do not conflict with General Plan policies and standards, thereby enhancing consistency between the General Plan and Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds that the amendments will be in conformity with public convenience, general welfare, and good land use practice, in that the revisions are also intended to clarify the regulations and facilitate ease of use and understanding, as well as to establish appropriate standards and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds that the amendments will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, and general welfare, and will not adversely affect the orderly development of property, in that they will harmonize the Zoning Code with State law, better express the City's policies, and generally promote good land use planning and regulation.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Planning Commission does hereby recommend that the City Council adopt the proposed Ordinance (Attachment A) amending Title 17 Zoning text based upon the following findings:

### **CEQA**

<u>Finding:</u> The Planning Commission hereby finds the proposed amendment to Title 17 is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Evidence: In accordance with the requirements of CEQA, the Planning Commission has analyzed this proposed zoning text amendment and finds that Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines provides that CEQA only applies to projects that have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment; the activity is not subject to CEQA. The amendment to the Zoning Code specifies parking requirements and does not change the amount or intensity of development that would occur in association with a project. The amendment to the Zoning Code does not relate to any one physical project and will not result in any physical change to the environment. Development accommodated under the project would be consistent with intensities and densities allowed under the existing Zoning Code, existing General Plan, and existing requirements of State law.

### **GENERAL PLAN**

<u>Finding:</u> The Planning Commission hereby finds proposed amendment to Title 17 is consistent with the General Plan.

<u>Evidence</u>: The amendment to Title 17 implements the General Plan, including the Land Use Element land use designations. The proposed amendment to Title 17 would not introduce uses, land use densities or intensities, or development standards that are inconsistent with development allowed under the General Plan, including uses, densities, and standards required to be accommodated by State law.

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IONE AMENDING THE IONE MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 17 ZONING, TABLE 17.40.050-1

Whereas, the Planning Commission conducted a duly-noticed public hearing on the Zoning Code Amendments – Table 17.40.050-1 project (Project) on August 6, 2023 and adopted a resolution forwarding the proposed Project to the City Council and recommending its adoption; and

Whereas, adoption and implementation of the Project is determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act as it meets with the criteria established in Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines because there will be no physical changes to the environment and requires no further review pursuant to Section 15168(c)(2); and

Whereas, on \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2023, the City Council conducted a duly-noticed Public Hearing, deliberated, and considered the Project materials; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the Project is consistent with the General Plan goals, policies, and implementation programs and is compatible with the general objectives of the General Plan, in that the amendments implement and do not conflict with General Plan policies and standards, thereby enhancing consistency between the General Plan and Zoning Code; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the Project will be in conformity with public convenience, general welfare, and good land use practice, in that the revisions are also intended to clarify the Zoning Code regulations and facilitate ease of use and understanding, as well as to establish appropriate standards and procedures; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that the Project will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, and general welfare, and will not adversely affect the orderly development of property, in that they will harmonize the Zoning Code with State law, better express the City's policies, and generally promote good land use planning and regulation.

The City Council of the City of Ione does ordain as follows:

### Section 1: Amendment of Title 17 Zoning

The text of Ione Municipal Code, Title 17, Zoning, is hereby amended to repeal and replace the affected portions of Title 17, including Table 17.40.050-1, as shown in Exhibit A.

### Section 2: No Mandatory Duty of Care

This ordinance is not intended to and shall not be construed or given effect in a manner that imposes upon the City or any officer or employee thereof a mandatory duty of care towards persons and property within or without the City, so as to provide a basis of civil liability for damages, except as otherwise imposed by law.

### Section 3: Severability

If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable. This City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance irrespective of the invalidity of any particular portion thereof and intends that the invalid portions should be severed and the balance of the ordinance enforced.

### Section 4: Environmental Review

The City Council hereby finds this ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines. A Notice of Exemption will be prepared.

### Section 5: Prior Violations

Neither the adoption of this ordinance nor the repeal or amendment by this ordinance of any ordinance or part or portion of any ordinance previously in effect in the City, or within the territory comprising the City, shall in any manner affect the prosecution for the violation of any ordinance, which violations was committed prior to the effective date of this ordinance, nor be construed as a waiver of any license, fee, or penalty, or the penal provisions applicable to any violation of such ordinances.

### Section 6: Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days following its adoption by the City Council. A summary of this ordinance shall, within fifteen (15) days after passage, be published in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code of the State of California with the names of the City Council members voting for and against it.
