THE COMMUNITY

Located in the beautiful Sierra foothills of Northern California, the City of Lone is a quaint, yet active community. The community offers a wide range of housing, world-class outdoor activities, and recreational opportunities in close proximity in every direction. An extensive array of parks and natural resources offer unbeatable experiences. The City is a short drive to Lake Tahoe and Sacramento where you can enjoy everything from fine dining and ballet to the best of rural living and more. Nestled in the heart of Amador County's wine country, the City of Lone is characterized by its oak tree lined hills and small-town atmosphere.

THE ORGANIZATION

The City of Lone was incorporated as a General Law city in 1953. The City has a Council-Manager form of government with five elected Council members who serve four-year terms. The Council appointed City Manager is responsible for financial and operational management of the City's 32 paid employees, 21 fulltime, 2 part time, and 9 on-call employees. The mission of the City Council, staff, commissions, committees, and volunteers is to foster and maintain the City of Lone as a great place to live and raise a family. Departments include City Manager, Police, Public Works, Finance, HR, and Fire. The FY 2022 Operating Budget for the City of Lone is \$4.0 million.

THE DEPARTMENT

The City of Lone Police Department is a full-service law enforcement agency comprised of 8 sworn fulltime peace officers, 2 sworn reserve officers, and 20 volunteers. The Department is led by the Police Chief who is supported by one Police Sergeant and two Police Corporals.

The Lone Police Department personnel strive to provide high quality police services to the community. Promoting positive interactions and building and maintaining strong community partnerships are paramount. The Department is proud of the outstanding partnership they enjoy with their community and are dedicated to working together to identify and resolve issues that impact the quality of life in Lone. The Department is committed to the community's public safety priorities—Cops for Kids, National Night Out, and the You Are Not Alone (YANA) Program.

The core services provided by the Department are: response to emergency and non-emergency calls for service; proactive identification of criminal activity; traffic safety; investigation of crime and prosecution of criminals; training of personnel; crime prevention and community outreach; maintenance of records; property and evidence control and emergency preparedness.

- Vacation: 0-3 years of service, 80 hours annually; 4-8 years of service, 120 hours annually; 9+ years of service, 160 hours annually
- Sick Leave: 96 Hours annually
- Education and POST Certification incentives up to 10%
- Educational cost reimbursement up to \$2,000 per year
- 10 Paid Holidays; Overtime earned at 1.5 times; 80-Hour work period
