If you have a home generator, make sure the surrounding area has proper clearance and no combustibles are near the exhaust pipe or any opening into your home to prevent carbon monoxide poisoning.

#### Cops4Kids Program

The Cops4Kids (C4K) Program is currently being used by the Ione Police Department with Sergeant Carlo Sgroi as the administrator for the classes being taught in the Ione schools. The 10-week class covers anti-bullying and building the children's self-image as well as what the DARE program covered in the past (drug and alcohol awareness). It focuses on helping the students understand that it is good to stay in school and shows them how they can contribute to their community. In the beginning, the C4K Program was for 4th and 5th grade students only, but in 2022 the program was expanded to include 6th-8th graders too! The program also teaches what Law Enforcement and First Responders do for our community.

#### National Purple Heart Day—August 7th

George Washington awarded the original Purple Heart, designated as a Badge of Merit, in 1782. The Badge of Merit faded from use but was revived and launched in 1932, this time as the Purple Heart. As well as honoring those wounded in combat, this iteration of the Purple Heart recognized commendable action. It was in 1944 that the policy was changed slightly and the Purple Heart was given the purpose we know it for today, specifically to honor those who have been wounded or died in active duty. In total there have been 1.8 million Purple Hearts awarded over the years. Purple Heart Day was first observed in 2014 and has been observed every year since. It's a chance to reflect on the bravery of those who have fought for the U.S. and to ensure that their courage is never forgotten.
