City of Ione Fire Department Announcement:

1. Address Numbers are always a great concern for the emergency services. Please go out both in the day and night time to observe if you can clearly see your address from the street. If you can't, we can't! There must be a minimum of 3-inch numbers and contrast with their background.
2. Burn permits are required for any outdoor yard burning in the City. Burn hours differ from the County. Our burn hours are 6:00 A.M. until Noon on a permissive burn day. Pick up burn permits at City Hall. Call the Amador Air Pollution line before burning and follow the rules on the burn permit.
3. Power lines to your home in the areas of the City with above ground services: please check the service drop to your home to assure there are no hazardous limbs that may fall during a storm or wind event and take down your line. If you see a downed power line, cable TV, or telephone line down, please never touch it! Call 911—the line may be touching a power line on the pole. Remember, safety first!
