City of Ione Fire Department Announcement:

It's that time of year again! It's time to start cleaning around your property and making it ready for the upcoming summer months.

Cut your grass and weeds, clear the combustibles down to two (2) inches or less, and remove all cuttings from the property.

Cut all low hanging limbs and remove trees and brush from around your home, driveway access, or power lines.

Report any hazards in your neighborhood to the Fire Department.

Burn permits are still required in the City limits but are suspended when fire season is declared so get all your piles burned as soon as possible, burning must be done correctly and safely.

Wildland fires affect all of us in the rural communities and we ALL need to do our part. Please take care of the hazards and keep our community and citizens safe!

Public Works Department Announcement:

Personnel from Public Works will be covering all areas of the City this month taking inventory of streets, sidewalks, curbs, and gutters that are in need of repair. This is part of the planning process for project review and budget.
