<u>City of Ione Fire Department Announcement:</u>

Spring Cleaning: It's time to start working on clearing your property and spraying for the weeds. Take control of vegetation now and provide the needed clearances to safeguard your homes and property from fires. Cut and remove combustible vegetation and remove any low hanging tree limbs that may cause access problems or a threat to your home, and make sure you call PG&E before working around any electrical wires.

<u>Burn Permits:</u> Burning in the city limits is still authorized with a valid burn permit obtained at City Hall. Burn hours are from 6:00 A.M. to Noon on a valid burn day. Piles are not to exceed 4x4ft in size.

Public Works Department Announcement:

Fallen trees in Howard Park occur each year after the storms. Public Works wants to remind everyone to always practice safety and stay alert while at the park, watch out for falling or unstable trees, and report them to City Hall so we can get crews out to fall the trees or mark them with caution tape until it's safe to be removed.

For any persons who are interested in cutting up the fallen trees at Howard Park, you are required to obtain a wood cutting waiver from City Hall prior to any cutting.
